

2019-2020 Academic Year Financial Requirements for International Students

Newly enrolled international students must complete a certification of finances questionnaire and upload the verification of finances document (bank statement or letter) through the Terra Dotta system. These documents are required for the issuance of an I-20 or DS-2019 form. The amount required to be substantiated is an estimated total of tuition, departmental fee, living expenses and other costs such as supplies and health insurance for one academic year.
