Going off-campus for medical services:

SVA **does not** provide medical services on-site. Know the locations to the nearest medical facilities **BEFORE** you become ill. If you need to see a doctor, but are uncomfortable with your English skills, **ask a friend** who speaks English, **to go with you**. Proper communication is very important!

You have several choices:

- **Private doctors and/or Specialists**, treat non-emergency patients by appointment during regular office hours, typically 9 a.m. until 5 p.m.
- Minor emergency clinics, or **Urgent Care**, do not require appointments, and are usually open during the week, on the weekends, and holidays. Urgent Care means you can simply walk in for most medical services. However, specialists require an appointment be made.
- In case of serious emergency, go to the nearest **Hospital Emergency Room** -- by ambulance if necessary. Hospital emergency rooms are designed to treat life-threatening conditions; this is typically the most expensive place to receive care.

Always carry your **Insurance ID Card** with you. If you are enrolled in the SVA –sponsored student insurance, visit www.sva.edu/uhp, click on *Login to My Account* and *Create an Account*. Enter your name, date of birth, and your SVA email address. Create a user name & password and log in to print your Insurance ID Card. New Insurance ID Cards must be printed out each fall, displaying the current academic year.
