Description:

SVA Career Development will cover the \$1,500 tuition fee plus a \$500 travel stipend for up to two (2) SVA alumni or students who are accepted into Anderson Ranch's Artist-in-Residence Program annually. The tuition fee covers housing, studio space, and meals during the 10-week residency in Snowmass Village, CO.

Anderson Ranch's Artists-in-Residence Program fosters creative and intellectual growth for emerging and established visual artists. Residents have access to world-class facilities at the Ranch and 10 weeks of uninterrupted studio time. Anderson Ranch provides studios, facilities, a community of working artists, and feedback from visiting artists and critics. The Ranch setting is specifically crafted to aid artists in the production of their work, free from the distractions of everyday life. Residencies run in fall and spring.

Eligibility:

- Award is open to current SVA students, and SVA alumni from degree programs.
- Open to U.S. citizens and non-U.S. citizens.
- You must first apply to and be accepted by Anderson Ranch's jurying process to be eligible for SVA funding.
- Residencies are offered to artists who work in one of the following media: ceramics, new media, photography, furniture design, woodworking, painting, drawing, printmaking, and sculpture.

Application Process & Components

- Apply to Anderson Ranch by their annual deadline and meet criteria of their application process.
- In your application, be sure to note your SVA enrollment or degree.
- You are responsible for the \$60 Anderson Ranch application fee, studio fees, cost of your own materials, and any travel costs exceeding the \$500 travel stipend provided by SVA.
- If you are selected by Anderson Ranch, they will notify SVA and we will contact you to arrange your award.
